




CARBON DIOXIDE SOURCES AND SINKS





Compounded effects of El Niño on top of a warming climate.








Design Strategies

Flexibility & Re-use

- Flexible, movable furniture
- Furniture pieces that can be repurposed
- Trials of glueless flooring
- Retrofit designed to revamp and re-use existing furniture








Example Sourcing Guidelines

Timber

- Re-used, reclaimed prefered
- Chain of custody
- No red-flag country
- Playwood E1
- As locally sourced as possible

Paints

- Ecolabel or EPD
- NOT TESTED ON ANIMALS
- Zero/low VOCs







Below: Recycled worktops, single material.

Retrofit

During the build

Include specs in contracts

- Particular suppliers specified, e.g Crown Paints, Nordbord OSB, Danskin underlay, Natrahemp insulation
- Targets for diversion from landfill
- Instructions for re-use / repurpose

Renewable energy on site

Switch early in the project

Aligned Contractors

Build relationships with people that care

Greenleases

- Requirements built into contracts
- Pressure both ways
- Prioritising landlords that care

Landlord Collaboration

- Germany: lighting retrofits & PV
- Australia: capex budget
- Cannot wait for legislation, too late!
- Help meet each others' climate commitments

- Lush North America: 20% energy reductions
- Engagement and behavioural change
- + Controls, lighting refurbs

Integration

Environmental responsibilities
 with maintenance and facilities teams
 written into their job descriptions

MOVE FORWARD EACH TIME YOU:

- Turn off the light before leaving a room
- Only boil the amount of water you need in the kettle
- Turn an appliance off at the wall when not in use i.e. toaster/microwave
- Top up cooling demo water with preboiled hot water in a flask
- Try adding/removing layers before adjusting the AC/heating
- Use unused demo water in your mop bucket or for cleaning.

- Ensure system is in place for making use of it
- E.g.: Crown, Mosa, Prolight, Amari

Greenhub

- Infrastrucuture for the circular economy
- Backhaul, sorting, storage, workshop, re-use.

Circle it back into design!




Lush Liverpool


